This process involves the work of special machines, dyeing the fabric in blue and unlimited use of water.

One of the important steps forward is the processing of jeans with nitrogen without water and chlorine.

Well, with the help of processing, of two old jeans, one can make one new, and from three combine a new denim jacket. It is interesting that the designers aim to not only create a brand new thing, but also an interest in preserving the environment by recycling old things into new ones.

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
